A Message to the Conference of World Philosophers  
in Pune, India, October 1996

Dear friends, having been labeled by my Hindu friends at the United Nations a trikaldarshi and a trilokonath, and named Purushottama by our Hindu spiritual master Sri Chinmoy, having been inspired in India to write my first book, a novel in which I fell in love with India, Sima My Love, which received a French literary prize and opened the way to many more writings, you will understand my unhappiness not to be able to be with you in your truly extraordinary conference on the eve of a new century and millennium.

My dear and deeply admired friend for many years, Claes Nobel, has asked me to address you a brief message.
